Contest Dates

On or about May 13, 2016: winning entry will be selected

How to Enter or Participate for a Chance to Win

Enter online during the Entry Period at www.wcsx.com by completing and submitting the online entry form and telling us about an elementary school you would like to nominate to win an ice cream party. Entry form must be filled out completely, including all required contact and personal information, to be entered into the contest.
